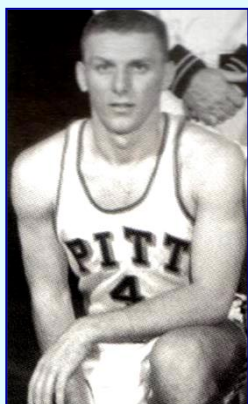
## Learn from an Instructor with Proven Ability...

Dave Roman is widely known for his mastered ability to make a high number of consecutive baskets from the foul line and beyond the arc. Some of his documented demonstrated bests include:

- 171 Consecutive Free Throws
- 62 Consecutive 3-Pointers from Around the Arc
- 45 Consecutive Free Throws with Eyes Closed
- 20 Consecutive 3-Pointers with Eyes Closed from Top of Circle

## ...and the Credentials

Dave Roman earned several All-American and All-East honors both at Johnstown College (now UPJ) and Pitt. Before going on to Pitt, he played 1 1/2 seasons at Johnstown College where he still holds college scoring records. Among them are Single Game Score (54 points), Single Season Score (954 points), and 1 1/2 Season Score (1,446 points).



Dave Roman earned a full scholarship to Pitt in 1962 where he led the Panthers in scoring and to an NCAA bid his junior year, and an NIT bid his senior year. In those years, the Panthers were affectionately referred to as "Roman & Company" by sportswriters and fans alike.

In his junior year, he was named "Player of the Year" by Pittsburgh Sportswriters.

Dave also played one year in the Eastern Basketball League where he specialized in the 3-Point Shot. His successful coaching career spans from Graduate Assistant at Pitt, through Interim Professional Coach, to a 22-win season as a high school coach.

## Established in 1988

After years of seeing how the area basketball teams lacked the correct shooting fundamentals, Dave Roman founded the Dave Roman Shooting Camp in 1988 to teach kids that the art of shooting is a *learned* skill. Stressing that good shooters are self-made, not born, he teaches the proper techniques, form, and position.

For his ability to successfully correct a shooter's inaccurate shot, Dave has been nicknamed "The Shot Doctor" by the many skilled shooters who have received his instruction.

Over the years, many players that Dave has instructed since grade school have led the state of Pennsylvania's high schools in scoring.

Many players have scored over 1,000 and 2,000 career points, and have broken their high school and college 3-Point records. In addition, many players have earned scholarships.
